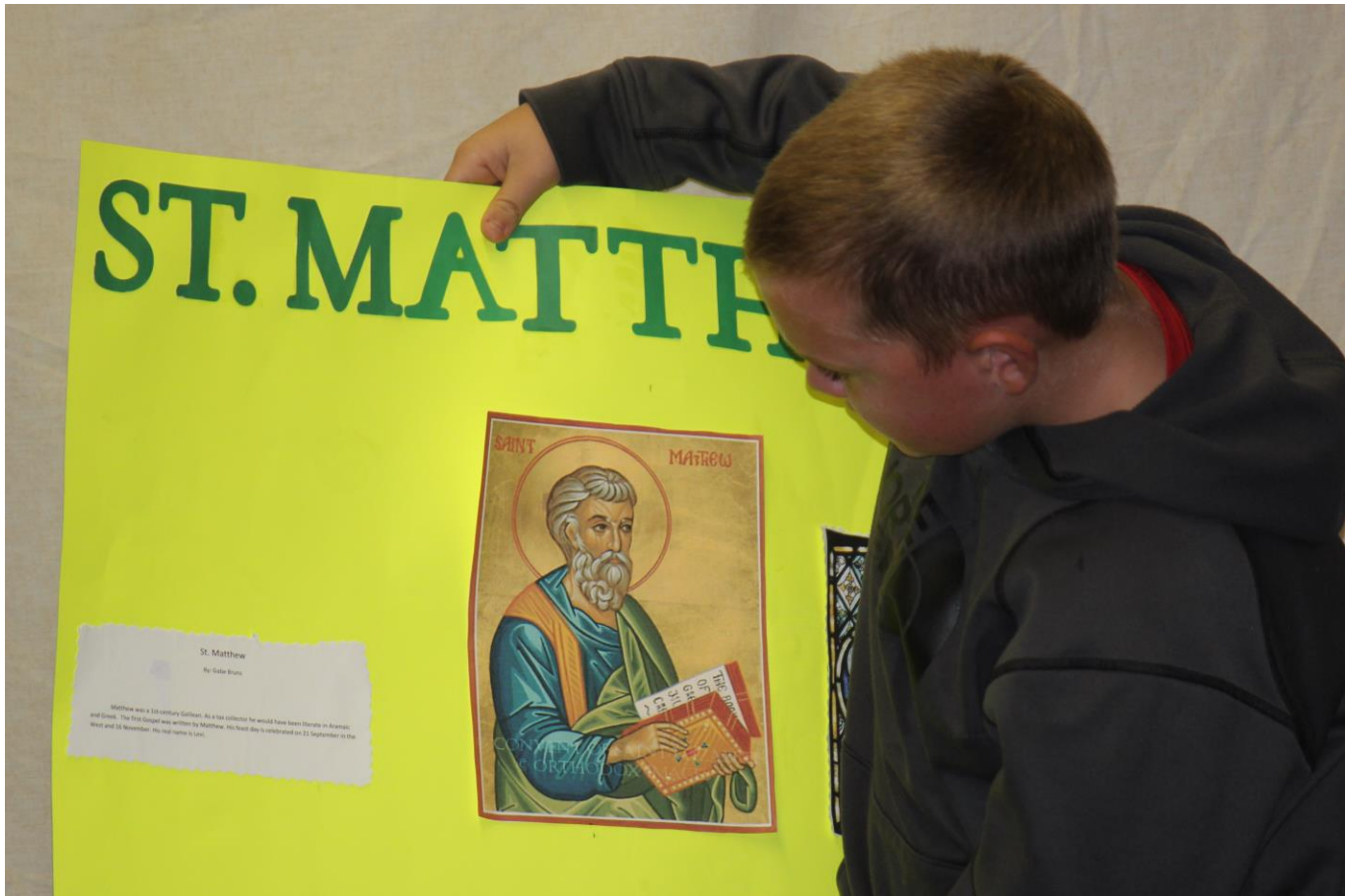


# St. Sebastian All Saint's Day Poster Presentations
