Fr. Matt opened the meeting with prayer.

- Discussed Hymnals and Missalettes – Need to order by August to get the next hymnals which will start of at Advent. All members were given information for cost per parish for a year. Talked about advantage/disadvantage of hymnals and missalettes. Possible purchase of hard bound hymnals. Worship aides are being printed FREE from LPI and they are willing to increase from 500 copies to 700 copies. Will continue for now the worships aides and order missalettes for those who want them to take home with them. The cluster had to pay USCCB \$300 for printing the readings and this is paid until Advent.
