- Financial:

Old Business:

- A few items still remain in the youth group room, some will be shared with religion classes and other groups utilizing the basement space
- One AC unit installation is completed, Rays has one more unit to install but no rush at this time
- Boiler repairs and maintenance were discussed after recent boiler concerns. The boilers need to be cleaned and given routine maintenance every couple of years. It is being discussed to schedule for every 5 years, rather than waiting for an issue to arise.

- Discuss filling the cleaning schedule while Elaine Homan is out due to surgery. Sue will reach out to Jason Schmackers. Some other individuals and companies (Service Master)
- Unified Council members Precious Blood would need to send 3 members to serve. Karen Homan, Trevor Wynk, and Nate Kirwen will plan to represent Precious Blood.
- Missalettes a request was made for additional missalettes. Missalettes cost approximately \$5.00/book. It is agreed that no additional quantity of missalettes will be ordered (250). Consider storing missalettes in a book case type of storage for parishioners to grab and use during mass, rather than place in each pew.
- 71 lights in the basements need to be replaced/upgraded to LED (142 bulbs), \$17.99/light (pair of LED bulbs). Total cost will be approximately \$1300. Council members voted in favor of approving the purchase of the bulbs.
- Discussed increasing the cost of basement rental to \$125 from \$100. All members are in favor of the price increase.
