

## St. Rose Parish Council Meeting

Thursday, December 5, 2019

### OLD BUSINESS

1. Church property that was damaged by the wind storm this summer has been fixed. New roof has been installed on the front porch and garage of the parish office. All three damaged church windows have been fixed or replaced.
2. Carl Bensman has installed the new railings on the handicap ramp.
3. Tony Homan has added pavers by the handicap ramp to prevent mulch from blowing into river rock there.
4. Flowers have been sent from the Parish Council to Rich Lochtefeld's funeral.
5. Excess water issues on the West side of church has been addressed. New tile, drainage spouts, and river rock have been placed on the west side of church to reduce water build up near the foundation.
6. Jim Bomholt has power washed a section of the stone wall to the cemetery.

### NEW BUSINESS

1. Going to remove two bushes behind the parish office and possibly two trees that are rotted.
2. Looking for someone to repaint the handicap and parking lines on the parking lot. Do in the spring.
3. Plans are set in the spring to replace the five front windows of the parish office.
4. A parishioner is looking to donate money to fund different parish projects. Some ideas that were discussed are...
  - a. Update the West side alter in church to display the Holy Oils. Plans would include lining an interior cupboard with marble and then installing a light, glass door, and shelf.
  - b. Updating the landscaping around the parish office by removing old bushes and replacing with new landscaping.
5. Purchasing a gas powered leaf blower that would be used to maintain the church grounds.
6. Scheduling a service appointment for the lawnmower with Randy Roeckner.
  - a. Work is needed on the lawnmower as there have been issues with it last mowing season.
  - b. The idea of possibly installing a 100 gallon fuel tank and only using ethanol free gas has been proposed to help maintain it.
7. Address cemetery stones issues by raising some tilting gravestones stones and pouring quikcrete to create a new level slab underneath.
